#### **Product description**

Penguard Special is a two-pack zinc phosphate pigmented epoxy coating based on an epoxy resin with high molecular weight.

#### Recommended use

Steel work in general, galvanized steel or aluminium. Usually used in combination with an epoxy or polyurethane system.

# Surface preparation

All surfaces should be clean, dry and free from contamination. The surface should be assessed and treated in accordance with ISO 8504.

#### Bare steel

Cleanliness: Blast cleaning to Sa  $2\frac{1}{2}$  (ISO 8501-1:1988). Roughness: using abrasives suitable to achieve grade Fine to Medium G (30-85  $\mu$ m, Ry5) (ISO 8503-2)

#### **Coated surfaces**

Clean, dry and undamaged compatible primer. Contact your local Jotun office for more information.

#### Other surfaces

For aluminium, galvanized and stainless steel, the surface must be clean and dray. Consult your local Jotun office for further details

The coating may be used on other substrates. Please contact your local Jotun office for more information.

## Condition during application

The temperature of the substrate should be minimum 10°C and at least 3°C above the dew point of the air, temperature and relative humidity measured in the vicinity of the substrate. Good ventilation is usually required in confined areas to ensure proper drying. The coating should not be exposed to oil, chemicals or mechanical stress until cured. If necessary, Penguard Stayer, Penguard Primer, Penguard HB, Penguard Special may be used down to 2°C, provided a special accelerator is added.

## **Application methods**

**Spray** Airless spray

**Brush** Recommended for stripe coating and small areas, care must be taken to achieve

the specified dry film thickness.

## **Application data**

Mixing ratio (volume) 4 parts Comp. A (base) to be mixed thoroughly with 1 part Comp. B

(curing agent).

Mixing ½ hour prior to use.

Pot life (23°C) 8 hours. (Reduced at higher temp.)

**Thinner/Cleaner** Jotun Thinner No. 17

Guiding data airless spray

**Filter** Check to ensure that filters are clean.

## **Drying time**

Drying times are generally related to air circulation, temperature, film thickness and number of coats, and will be affected correspondingly. The figures given in the table are typical with:

- \* Good ventilation (Outdoor exposure or free circulation of air)
- \* Typical film thickness
- \* One coat on top of inert substrate

1 Provided the surface is free from chalking and other contamination prior to application, there is normally no overcoating time limit. If the coating has been exposed to direct sunlight for some time, special attention must be paid to surface cleaning and mattening/removal of the surface layer in order to obtain good adhesion.

The given data must be considered as guidelines only. The actual drying time/times before recoating may be shorter or longer, depending on film thickness, ventilation, humidity, underlying paint system, requirement for early handling and mechanical strength etc. A complete system can be described on a system sheet, where all parameters and special conditions could be included.

# Typical paint system

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#### Penguard Special 1-2 x 100 µm (Dry Film Thickness)

Normally topcoated with Epoxy or Polyurethane.

Other systems may be specified, depending on area of use

#### **Storage**

The product must be stored in accordance with national regulations. Preferred storage conditions are to keep the containers in a dry space provided with adequate ventilation. The containers should be sealed tightly.

#### Handling

Handle with care. Stir well before use.

16 L. Comp. A (base) and 4 L. Comp. B (curing agent)
Packing may vary from country to country according to local requirements.
